## Ways of Adult Faith



Discovering faith anew, deepening the relationship with Christ, being in exchange with others, experiencing community in faith - this is the content of „Ways of Adult Faith“ (WeG).

To deepen the faith, a course for adults with weekly evening meetings is offered once a year.

There is also an annual faith weekend, which is open to all who are interested.

## Children’s Church



In our parish, children should have the opportunity to get to know God the Father and to develop a personal friendship with Jesus Christ.

- Parents and their preschool children are invited to the CHILDREN’S SERVICES. Fixed dates are Christmas Eve and Easter Sunday. You can find other dates during the year at [www.muenster-ingolstadt.de/kinderkirche](http://www.muenster-ingolstadt.de/kinderkirche).
- For children of primary school age, we offer a SUNDAY CATECHESIS once a month, parallel to the congregational service in the Minster. The catechesis about the Sunday Gospel, the church year, the sacraments and the saints are embedded in child-friendly praise and prayer. There will be an opportunity to ask questions and engage in conversation. The children experience a community and friendship with each other. The catechises are a good supplement to the First Communion preparation and helps to deepen the faith afterwards. The Sunday catechises will take place initially once a month in St Paul’s Hall. ## Minster Altar Servers



The Minster Altar Servers are a group of children, teenagers and young adults. Through their altar service in the Minster and the Church of St. Moritz, they nurture a close relationship with God. In group lessons and on various trips throughout the year, they become friends in a community where Christian values and standards apply. They do challenges and discover new places. Last but not least, being an altar server and later a group leader helps to strengthen their self-confidence. All who have already had First Communion are welcome! About three services per month are on the schedule for each altar server. Group sessions take place weekly on Friday afternoons.

## Scout Troop „The Minster Knights“



The Scout Association is the largest youth movement in the world. About 70 children, young people and adults belong to the local group of the Deutsche Pfadfinderschaft Sankt Georg (DPSG). Meetings for four age groups take place weekly on the Schutterberg, a large site with a scout hut in the heart of Ingolstadt. On several weekends they go camping and in the summer holidays they go on a summer trip. Between the ages of 7 and 20 (or as a leader), you can belong to a large community, experience fun, nature and adventure, learn how to pitch a tent and start a fire, take responsibility and make the world a little better.

## Legion of Mary



The Legion of Mary, founded 100 years ago in Dublin, is today a worldwide prayer community. Under the leadership of the Blessed Mother, it promotes the lay apostolate and deepens Marian devotion, inspired by the „Golden Book“ of St. Louis Mary of Montfort. Revived in 2016, the „Presidium of the Three Times Adorable Mother“ now exists in the parish. We are involved in „Eucharistic Adoration“ and take on tasks suggested by the parish priest, e.g. praying the Rosary in „Elisa.“ The „praying members“ devote themselves to praying the Rosary daily. The „active members“ meet with their spiritual leader Fr Hubert Gerauer every Wednesday at 3.30 p.m. in the Canisius Residence Hall (Canisius Konvikt).

## „Let’s talk ...“ over a glass of wine with God



This philosophical-theological discussion meets regularly (about once a month) at 7.30 p.m. at „Le Café“ to discuss God, faith, church and many other topics in a relaxed atmosphere. The meetings are deliberately also aimed at critics of religion or the church, seekers of meaning or doubters. It’s precisely the viewpoints and arguments from different „camps“ that enable interesting perspectives that go beyond one’s own horizons and are an enrichment for all participants. ## Minster Renovation Society Ingolstadt



The Minster Renovation Society (Münsterbauhütte) raises funds for the preservation of the Minster. Founded in 1963 for a major renovation, it is now being revived. The Society collects ideas and suggestions, looks at the building and its art treasures with a watchful eye and suggests appropriate measures. It also aims to impart knowledge about the building. Anyone can become a member and make a contribution to the Minster! Experts from the fields of architecture, history, monument preservation, art, etc. and all those who care about the Minster can actively participate.

## The Minster Choir Groups



- The PRE- SCHOOL (1st year) prepares for the children’s choir. The children are taught to read music and to sing from sight. Since the children usually cannot read yet, they learn the songs by heart. Rehearsal: Saturday 10.00 - 10.30 a.m.
- In the CHILDREN’S CHOIR (2nd - 5th school years), the children practise chants for regular liturgy. Part-singing is introduced mainly through canon singing. Rehearsal: Saturday 10.30 - 11.15 a.m.
- The MÜNSTERCHOR sings choral literature from the Renaissance to moderate Modernism. To ensure a balanced choral sound, great importance is given to a cappella singing. Of course, masses with orchestra, wind instruments or organ are also on the programme. Rehearsal: Friday 7.30 - 9.00 p.m.

Voice training has a firm place in every choir group. All rehearsals take place in the auditorium of the Gnadenhal School. There are no rehearsals during the school holidays.

## Chamber Choir of the St. Moritz Church



The Chamber Choir provides the music for the festive services at St. Moritz. Works by well-known masters are performed for choir and orchestra on the high feasts of the church year. About 20 singers belong to the small but fine choir under the direction of Christian Ledl. Outside the church services, the chamber choir organises concerts in St. Moritz together with other artists. Anyone who enjoys singing in a choir is cordially invited to join the St. Moritz Chamber Choir. Singing together is medicine! Rehearsals take place every two weeks on Fridays from 7.30 p.m. to 9 p.m. in the Deanery Hall in the Haus der Stadtkirche, Hieronymusgasse 3.

## Catholic Women’s Institute Ingolstadt Centre



The Women’s Institute is a community of over 100 women of mixed ages.

It offers social meetings, lectures and excursions. Furthermore, it upholds parish customs, e.g. herb bouquets, flower carpets on Corpus Christi, Rorate breakfast in Advent.

It’s about experiencing togetherness and helping to shape the community.

The half-year programme is available in the church and is published in the parish newsletter.
